**Title:** Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton ("City") finding that a public use and necessity exists to acquire fee simple title to a 1.656 acre tract of land situated in the Alexander Hill Survey, Abstract No. 623, City of Denton, Denton County, Texas ("Property Interests"), for the expansion, construction, maintenance, operation, and improvement of electrical transmission lines, facilities and structures, including substations; authorizing the City to acquire the Property Interests by either agreement or through the use of the power of eminent domain; authorizing the use of power of eminent domain to condemn the Property Interests if an agreement cannot be reached; authorizing the expenditure of funds; making findings; providing a savings clause and an effective date.
