SUBJECT

Receive a report and hold a discussion regarding mobility improvements.

BACKGROUND

During the August 26, 2017 City Council Retreat, the Council gave direction to staff to look at developing a plan of short-term improvements that would provide for better traffic flow within the City. As a result, staff has been working at identifying a list and developing the cost estimates. Pritam Deshmukh, Traffic Engineer will be reviewing the list with the Mobility Committee to seek input for further direction. Based on the feedback given, staff will work with the Finance Department and City Manager's Office to identify available funds. Staff will then develop a more detailed presentation that can be provided to the full City Council at an upcoming meeting.

STRATEGIC PLAN RELATIONSHIP

The City of Denton's Strategic Plan is an action-oriented road map that will help the City achieve its vision.
