#### **SUBJECT**

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton authorizing an agreement between the City of Denton, Texas and Denton Parks Foundation to be used for Scholarships for the Friends of the Parks Foundation; providing for the expenditure of funds; and providing for an effective date. (\$450)

#### **BACKGROUND**

This Agreement allows for the total expenditure of \$450 from Council Contingency Funds. (Council Member Dalton Gregory \$450)

Key provisions of the Agreement include:

- Funds shall be used by the Denton Parks Foundation for scholarships for the Friends of the Parks Foundation.
- In addition to other reporting requirements, documentation in the form of cancelled checks and/or corresponding receipts specifically detailing expenditure of funds for the purpose provided is required for reimbursement from these designated funds.

#### **FISCAL INFORMATION**

Funding for the Agreement will come from Council Contingency Funds.

#### **STRATEGIC PLAN RELATIONSHIP**

The City of Denton's Strategic Plan is an action-oriented road map that will help the City achieve its vision.
