SUBJECT

Receive a report, hold discussion and give staff direction regarding update to Simply Sustainable plan and timeline.

BACKGROUND

The City of Denton Sustainability Plan, *Simply Sustainable - A Plan for Denton's Future* (Plan) was adopted in February of 2012. At the time staff and council committed to keeping the plan a living document. Many of the action items identified in the Plan have been completed or are in progress. Staff has worked with the COE to update actions, goals and Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) throughout the past five years. With significant progress made completing action items and annual tracking staff is recommending an update of the full document. Staff is proposing new actions and tracking metrics as well as a new Focus Area on Resiliency. Staff is planning public meetings and a survey to determine community priorities. Staff will coordinate with Community Affairs to ensure wide saturation of the survey and information about public meetings.
