SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute a Cooperative Purchasing Program Agreement with the City of Richardson, Texas under Section 271.102 of the Local Government Code, to authorize City of Denton contracts for the purchase of various goods and services; authorizing the expenditure of funds therefor; and declaring an effective date (File 6441-Cooperative Purchasing Program Agreement with the City of Richardson).

FILE INFORMATION

Section 271.102 of the Texas Local Government Code, authorizes respective participating governments to enter into agreements for the purchase of goods and services. The attached Agreement is an authorization for the City of Denton to participate in contracts awarded by the City of Richardson and for the City of Richardson to participate in contracts awarded by the City of Denton. The contract will remain in effect until terminated by either party.

This Agreement will allow both entities to utilize contracts for goods and services competitively bid by the other party to the contract. The bid process followed by both entities meets all statutory bidding requirements. Upon approval of the Agreement, the City of Richardson intends to utilize the City of Denton's RFP 5442 for Construction of Traffic Signal Intersections (Exhibit 1).

RECOMMENDATION

Approve an Interlocal Cooperative Purchasing Program Agreement with the City of Richardson.
