SUBJECT

Receive a report from staff regarding various scenarios for moving the City of Denton toward 100% renewable energy.

BACKGROUND

On June 21, 2016, Denton Municipal Electric (DME) was given direction from City Council by Resolution R2016-014 to set goals of “achieving 100% renewable energy by 2035, while continuing to offer competitive electric rates and electric reliability to its customers.” Staff will be presenting different options for achieving 100% renewable power including the advantages and disadvantages to each.

The staff presentation will also include a discussion of the possibility of economically increasing physical renewable energy well beyond 70%, as well as pertinent information regarding the renewable energy market in Texas.

STRATEGIC PLAN RELATIONSHIP

The City of Denton’s Strategic Plan is an action-oriented road map that will help the City achieve its vision. The foundation for the plan is the five long-term Key Focus Areas (KFA): Organizational Excellence; Public Infrastructure; Economic Development; Safe, Livable, and Family-Friendly Community; and Sustainability and Environmental Stewardship.
